- Bank personnel
- Meter readers
- Volunteers, caregivers, drivers
- Pharmacy personnel
- Post office workers, letter carriers
- Restaurant personnel
- Grocery store clerks
- Churches, social clubs

The training is available at your convenience, at your place of business, or mine, your choice. The training session is about half an hour and can easily be done before work, at lunch, or during a staff meeting, day or evening. Whatever works for you.
