1. To raise awareness and further understanding of the issues of Abuse, Neglect and Self-neglect.
2. To outline basic information and the role for "Gatekeepers", so the Gatekeeper can help to protect our vulnerable citizens by being able to recognize indications that may signal a need for assistance.
3. To provide the context and background information that makes the Gatekeeper Program work:
 - BC Legislation: the Adult Guardianship Act
 - The Act's guidance to prevent and to address Abuse, Neglect and Self-Neglect:
 - By means of a "Community Response Network" (CRN) & its role.
 - By means of the two "Designated Agencies" (IHA and Community Living, BC) & their roles.
4. To provide information of where to inquire when concerned.
5. To provide information of what is involved if reporting a concern.
6. To provide related contact and information sources.
