The handyDART client uses the coupons to pay the dollar meter rate of taxi fare. For example, if a taxi fare is \$5.80, the passenger pays \$5.00 in coupons and 80 cents in change (taxi drivers do not give change on Taxi Saver coupons.). These vouchers are not transferable to other individuals or transit systems.
