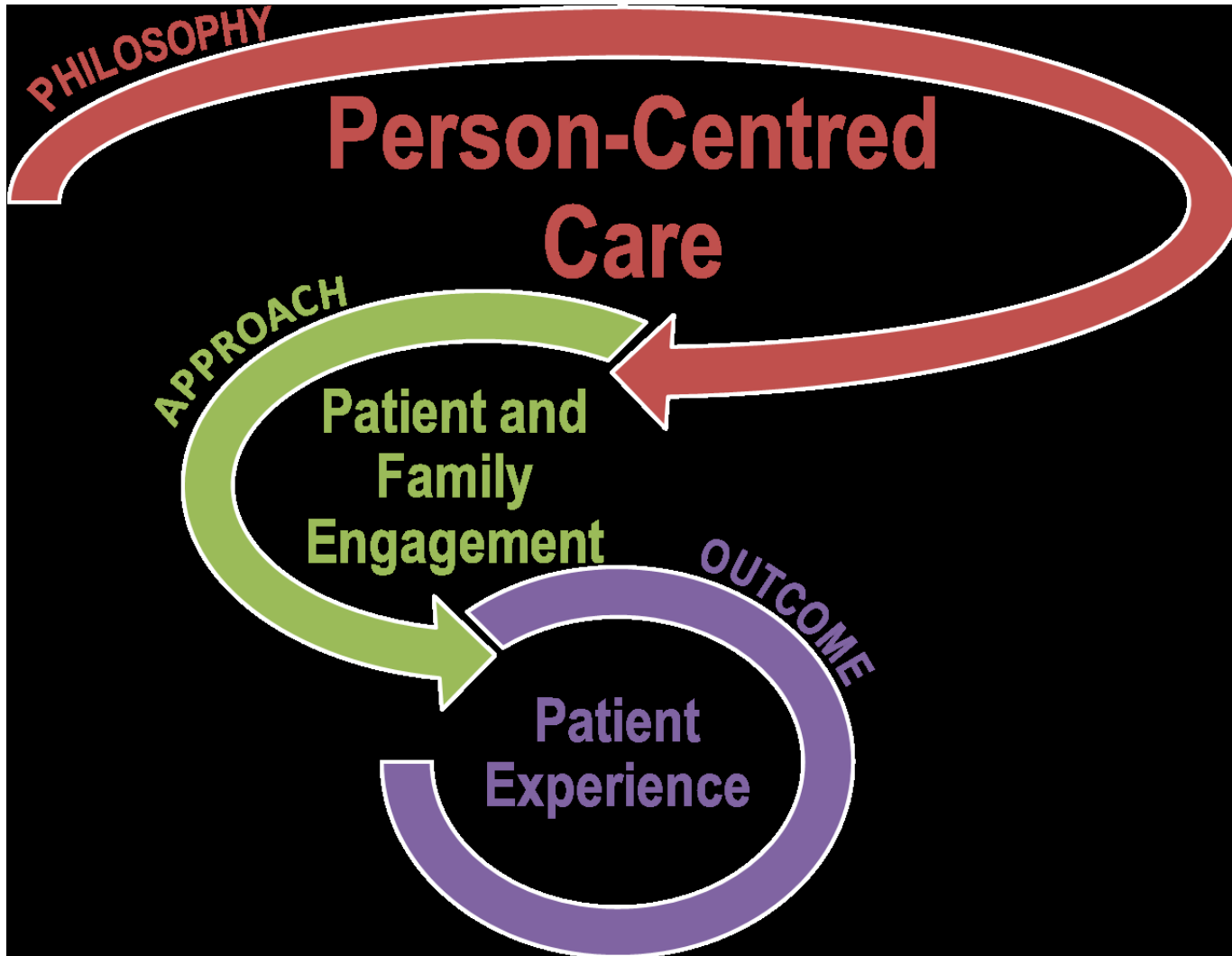
Created in 2008 by the Minister of Health

High quality and sustainable health care for all

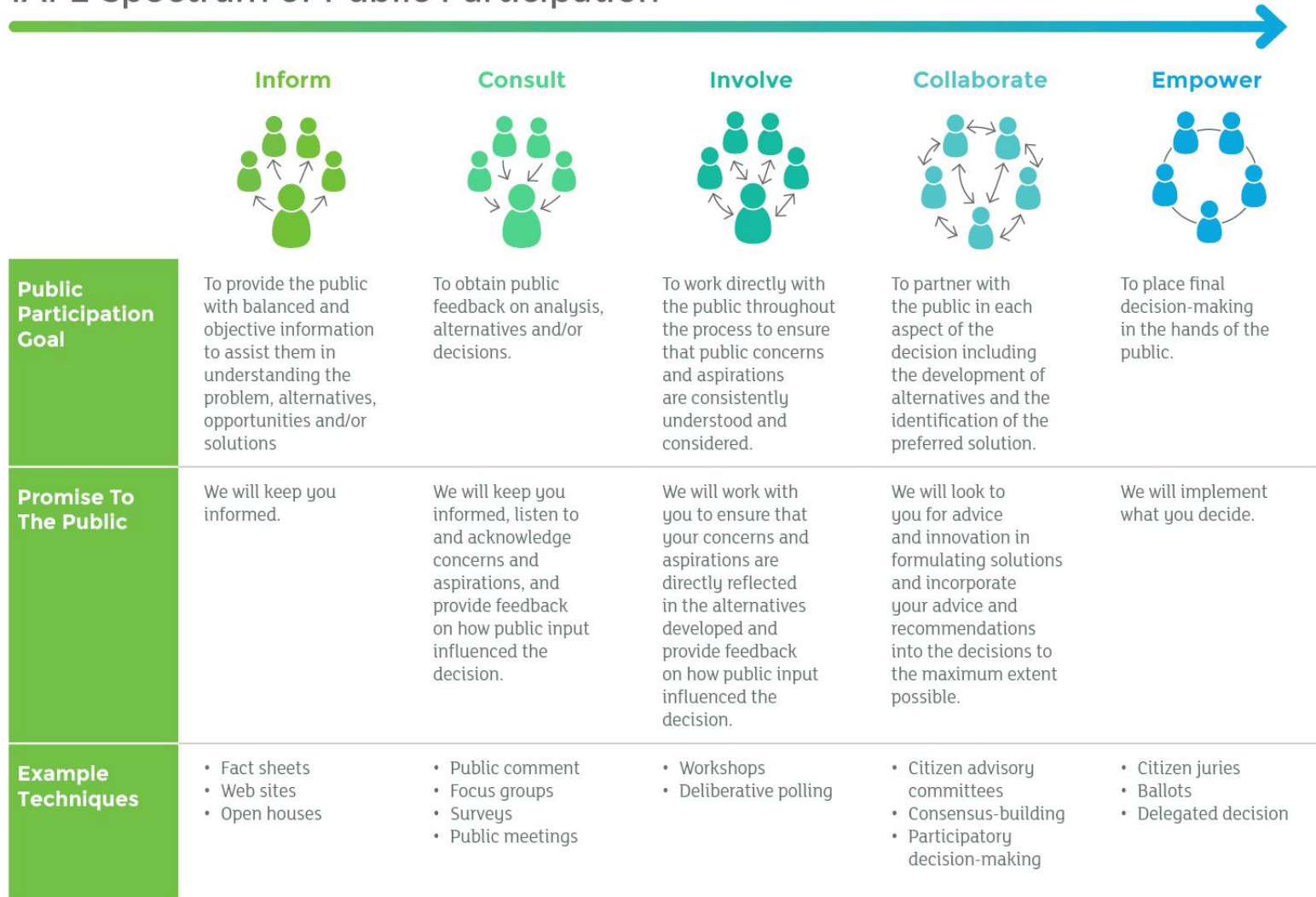
## **Mission:**

Provide system-wide leadership through collaboration with patients, caregivers, the public, and those working within the health system in a relentless pursuit of quality

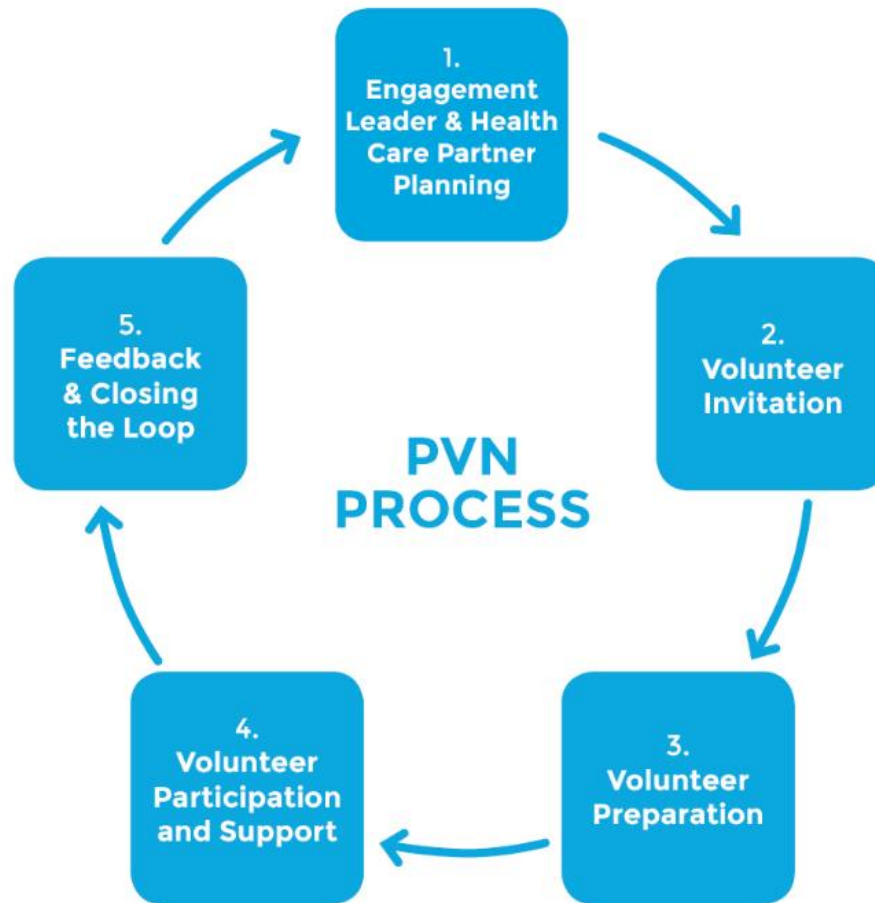

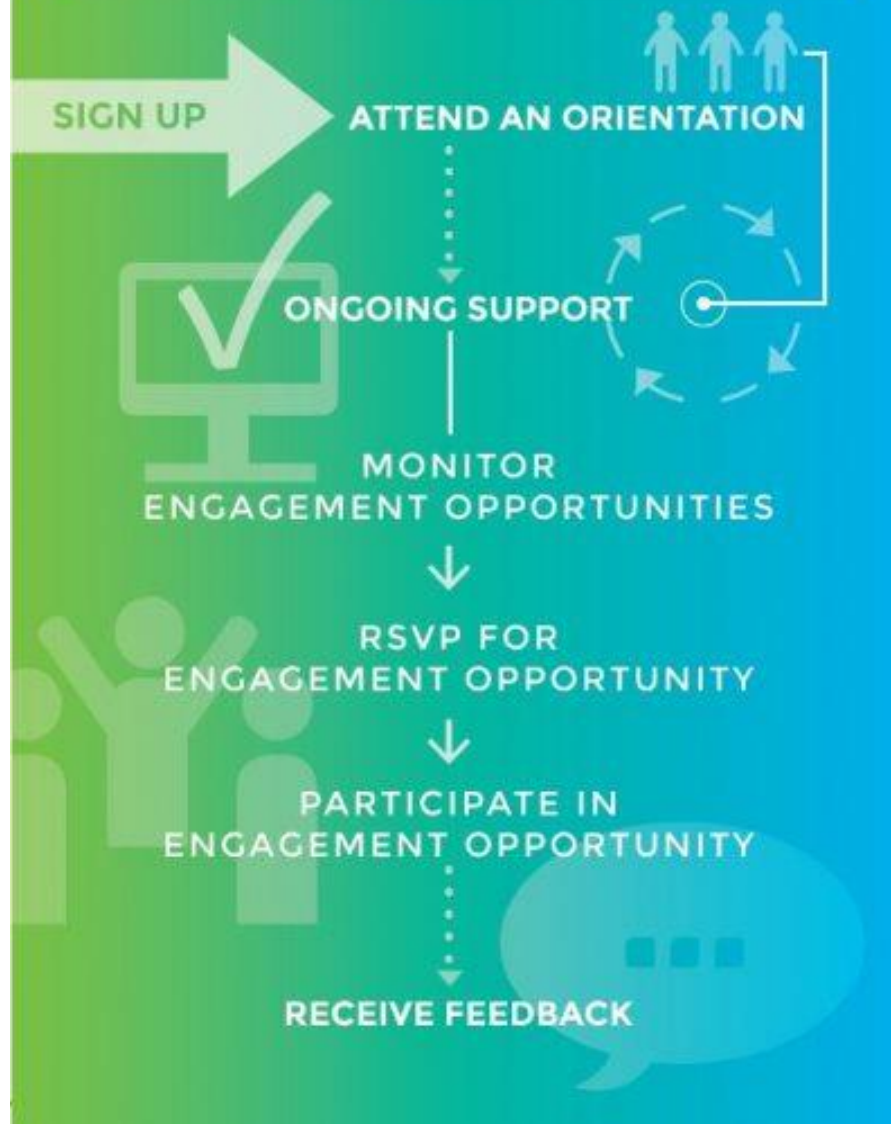
