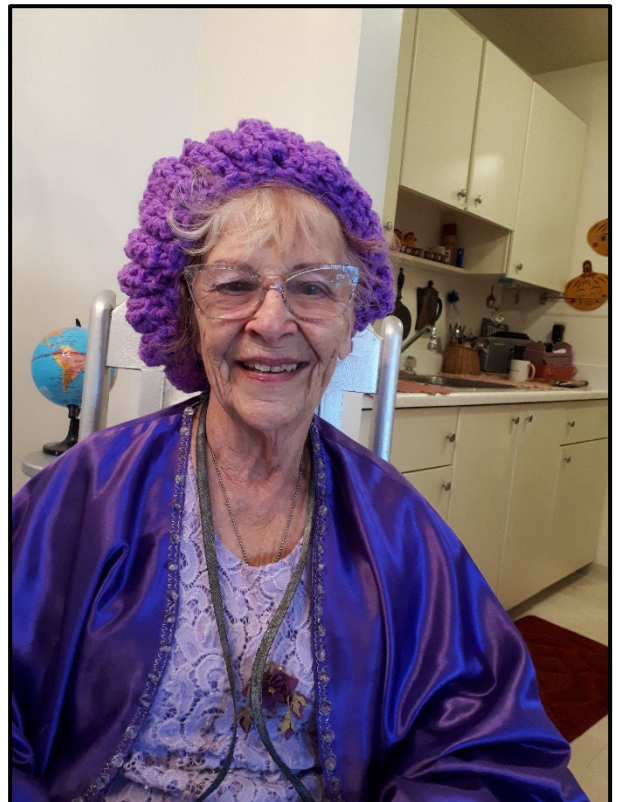


**Renata Zenk** with one of her crochet tams – she creates and wears one to match everyone of her outfits.

This project was a collaboration with the Saanich Peninsula Community Response Network (SPCRN), SHOAL Community Centre and the SHOAL Crafts Department, and the Mental Health Seniors Wellness Support Program. The SPCRN grant provided the cost of yarn, gift tags and clear plastic bags for packaging. SHOAL Centre Volunteers tied the tags to the tops of the tams and inserted dozens of them into the bags for COVID safe handling and distribution.
